Bring with you...

- 4 different types of treats, at least 2 of them high value. Bring enough so that you do not run out. water and a collapsible bowl.
- A favourite toy for your puppy - long plush squeaky toys work well.
- Paper towel to clean up accidents in stores.
- Any other gear needed for specific outings like swimming or hiking.

Reminders

- Always monitor your puppy's body language and let him decide who he meets and what he explores. If he is uncomfortable in any situation move away. If he is not interested in meeting a particular person he should never be forced to.
- Be aware of your environment. Try to see it from your puppy's point of view.
- It's perfectly okay to carry your pup often. It provides a breather for your puppy and you.
