Multi-Solve Setups - Think creatively

Two Toys, Two Solves

Stuff a Toppl treat and a Hol-ee Roller, put the Toppl on a level your dog will need to climb on to access, put the Hol-ee Roller in a different spot.

Stuff it, Wrap it, Hide it

Stuff paper towel rolls with food, jam into Hol-ee Roller ball, wrap Hol-ee roller with old towel, place under a hidden box.

Tips

- Play everyday.
- Play inside and out.
- Try playing at a park or other public spot where it's safe to do so.
- Increase the difficulty as your pup is ready.
- Food stuffing doesn't need to be difficult. Use your dog's regular meal food as well as tasty additions.
- Use what your dog loves. If you and your dog play with tugs and balls, incorporate them. Hide them and play when they find them. Repeat!

Supplies

- Paper towel rolls
- Cardboard boxes
- Brown paper bags of the right thickness
- Brown packing paper
- Old towels

Food Stuffing Inspiration

Simple - Your dog's kibble in paper roll, paper bag or box.

Meal Time - Your dog's wet or raw food in a Toppl or equivalent toy.

Tasty Combo - A chunk of chicken, dry biscuit and smear of nut butter in Toppl.
